

## **LRAP Eligible Employers List** *as of August 20, 2018*

Loan repayment assistance program (LRAP) participants must work as a lawyer for an eligible employer, defined as a DC-based, non-profit, tax-exempt charitable organization that provides free, direct civil legal services to the District's low-income or underserved residents and that is eligible for funding from the DC Bar Foundation. Applicants may also be in the process of seeking employment with an eligible employer.

Employers seeking to be added to the 2019 LRAP Eligible Employers List must complete and submit the eligible employer application online which will be released early September and due by 5:00 pm EST on Thursday, October 18, 2018.
